DATA PROTECTION

URGENT – NEW REGULATIONS CAME INTO FORCE LAST FRIDAY, 25th! PLEASE ACT NOW.

We have all been receiving a number of communications from businesses or charities recently asking us to confirm our wish to remain on their database (or not!). This is because of the new General Data Protection Regulations, which came into effect last Friday. Churches are not exempt from these regulations, so we are asking you to complete the consent form we have produced – or indicate via email to our Office – that you are content for us to contact you concerning future church activities, within your church, the Cockermouth Area Team (CAT), the Mission Community, and the Diocese. *You can view our Data Protection Policy on our Cockermouth Area Churches website.* Our understanding is that, if you are on your church's Electoral Roll, you have 'implied consent' for us to contact you about any matter concerning your own church. However, there are several matters concerning the CAT, Mission Community and Diocese about which we might also want to contact you – which is why we are asking for your consent. Thank you to all those who have already responded. If you have not done so, please may we invite your response as soon as possible? Thank you.
